# Come Holy Spirit!

This month we conclude our seven-week joyful season of Easter, with the excitement of the feast of the Holy Spirit, called Pentecost!

During the seven weeks of Easter, in church, we hear the gospel accounts of the resurrection appearances of Jesus to his disciples, and we read from the book of the Acts of the Apostles, about the amazing work of the first Christians.

On Pentecost we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon Jesus' followers, which empowered them not only to preach the Gospel in a way that everyone could understand, but it gave them courage

and strength to go out into the world and live their faith.

This experience of the coming of the Holy Spirit is something that is not confined to the pages of scripture. Jesus has sent the Holy Spirit to each of us as well. The Spirit of God dwells in our hearts, gives us courage when we need it, strength when we need it, patience, hope, love, faith. All these things are available to us if we but ask. The answer

is already present there, in our hearts, the presence of the Holy Spirit.

Sometimes we feel the Holy Spirit come powerfully. On April 29, Bishop Taylor will come and receive and confirm adults from our parish who want to become members of the Episcopal Church. The whole congregation will pray together with the bishop, and we will receive with joy the coming of the Holy Spirit in a special way.

On Pentecost, May 20, we will have baptisms, and will experience that sacred mystery of the sacrament that Jesus himself experienced. The priest will say "you are sealed by the Holy Spirit in baptism, and marked as Christ's own forever." These special feasts and important moments in the lives of our fellow Christians, remind us of our own relationship

# Habitat Q&A with Dan Wilson

The Habitat Build Day on April 21 was a great success! We asked Dan Wilson about the event and what was accomplished.

**Crossroads:** How many people from St. Cross came out?

**Dan Wilson:** We had a total of 19 folks there, 18 were workers and one of them was our meals coordinator (it's St Cross and the spread

was fabulous). We were in South Central LA. Arrived around 8 a.m. and left about 2:30 p.m.

Crossroads: Tell us about the home you worked on, and did you get to meet the homeowner?

**Dan:** This was not a new-build for Habitat. This was a renovation on an existing home. Habitat for Humanity has a program where they renovate older homes, going into neighborhoods that could use a little sprucing up. Our job that day was painting the outside of the house.

The homeowner was an elderly retired woman living there on her own. We were able to meet her that afternoon. She came out and was thrilled with the way it all looked!

Crossroads: What's next for St. Cross Habitat?

**Dan:** This was the first of two builds for St Cross this year (we try to do two per year). Our next one will be coming up in the fall, probably in October. No date has been set as yet. We rarely know this far out where we it will be, but after talking with our contact at H4H that day, we will probably be at a newbuild site which is breaking ground in Culver City sometime this summer.


